

The First 4T #first4T Competition(s) Terms and Conditions

1. The Promoter is Diabetes Australia (ABN 47 008 528 461) whose registered office is at 101 Northbourne Ave, Turner, ACT, 2612.
2. Entry into the competition will be deemed as acceptance of these terms and conditions. Entries must comply with these conditions to be valid.
